1947 - The year India was divided.

The 1947 partition of India and Pakistan was a catastrophic event and it continues to haunt the memories of both the nations even after 63 years. It displaced up to 12.5 million people and millions lost their lives during the partition. The impact was not just restricted to the loss of lives in Bengal and Punjab but it also affected the trade and business in the Indian Sub-continent. Since then the trade relations between these two nations have been strained.
