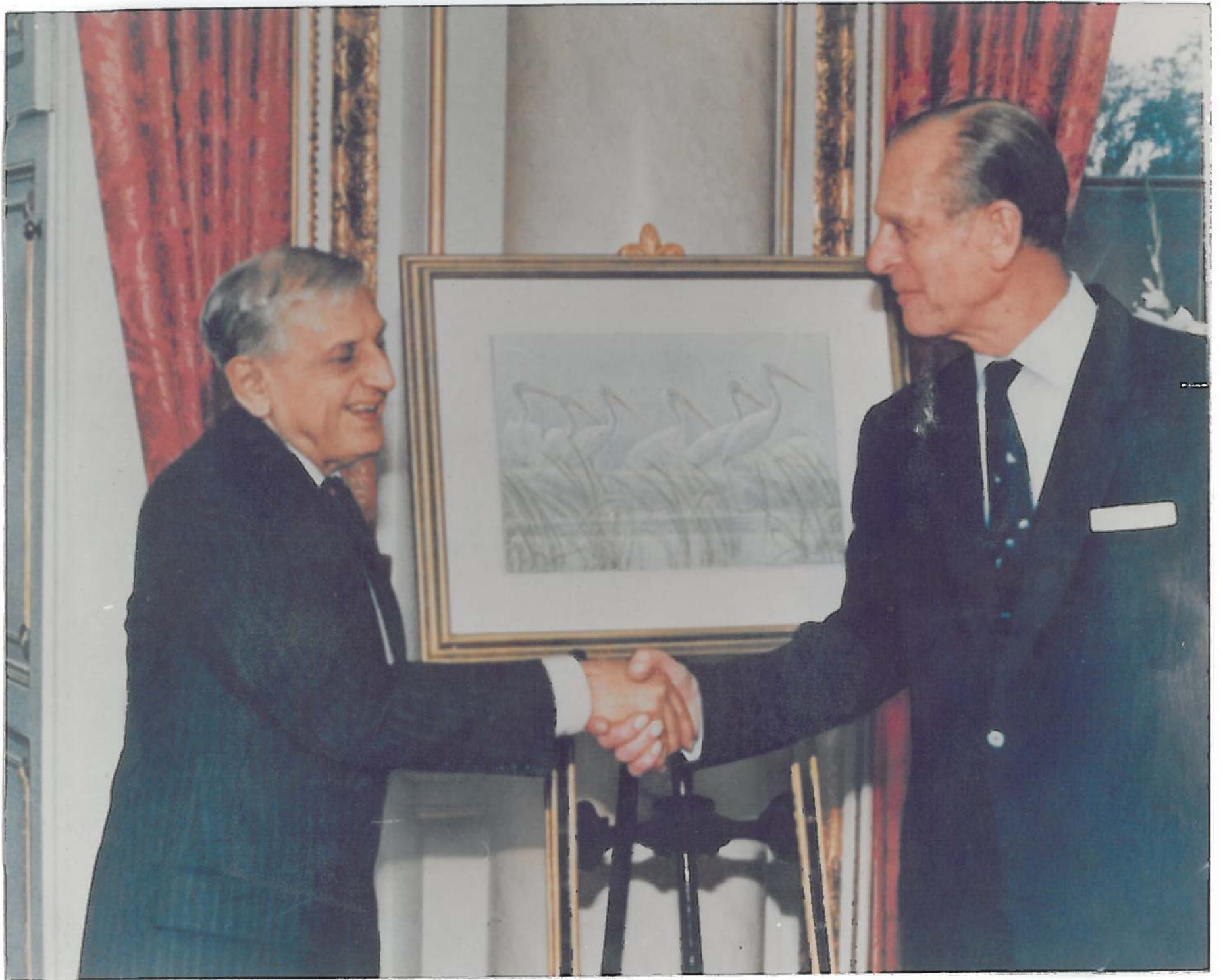


Document of the Month

2012 marks the birth centenary of our former Chairman – Late Sohrab Godrej (1912-2000) and to commemorate the man, this year Godrej Archives dedicates ‘the Document of the Month’ this year to his memory of Sohrab Godrej. From June 2012 through May 2013, we will bring to you interesting insights into the life of this illustrious industrialist.

Born in 3rd June 1912, Sohrab Godrej like his father inculcated since the beginning a deep sense of love for nature. He was the doyen of all activities related to nature and was associated with several organisations committed to the cause of environment. Sohrabji's association with WWF – India helped immensely in the cause of saving wildlife, particularly the Tiger. In 1969, when WWF –India was founded, Sohrabji became the Founder-trustee and later he also became the President Emeritus of WWF- India. For his relentless zeal & efforts towards conservation of nature, he was honoured as the ‘WWF 25th Anniversary Benefactor’ on 21 June 1991 & was awarded a print of Robert Bakeman's famous painting ‘The White Pelicans’ at the hands of Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh (Founder, WWF-International).
