Godrej was the first Indian company to manufacture an all-Indian typewriter in 1955. The Swadeshi spirited company took up the challenge of mass manufacturing of this complex equipment assembled using about 2000 components. Equal in performance to foreign makes, yet almost half their price, the Godrej Typewriter embodied precision and soon attracted big customers including the public sector enterprises in India.

This month we bring you a circular dated May 20th, 1958 which proudly informs all the branches that there was a successful demonstration of Godrej typewriters to Air India and that they had decided to purchase and use these typewriters in all their stations in India.
