GODREJ CENTENARY STAMP

Stamp Issue Date: 11 July 1997

In the year 1992, the chief Post Master General, Maharashtra Circle, Mumbai approached the State Government with a proposal to bring out commemorative stamps in honour of distinguished personalities/ institutions from Maharashtra on the occassion of any memorable event related to them during the period from 1993 to 1997.

The State Government sought the information from SICOM (The State and Investment Corporation of Maharashtra Limited) regarding the personalities/institutions that have made outstanding contribution to the field of industry in Maharashtra. Subsequently it was decided to issue a commemorative stamp in memory of Ardeshir Godrej and Pirojsha Godrej, founder brothers of Godrej Group for the commemorative stamp to mark the Godrej Centenary (1997).

The stamp was released by the President of India K R Narayanan at a function held at Darbar Hall at Raj Bahvan, Mumbai on 11th July 1997 in presence of the then chairman of Godrej Group Mr. Sohrabji Godrej, the then Governor of Maharashtra Dr. P C Alexander, the then Chief Minister of Maharashtra Mr. Manohar Joshi and Dy. Chief Minister, Mr. Gopinath Munde.

The stamp features the Godrej Brothers Ardeshir and Pirojsha, and their contribution to building up the Country's economy along with their environmental and social concern.
